AL Medicaid (vouchers)

Medicaid's NET program is set up to help pay for rides to and from a doctor's office, clinic or other place for medical care. The ride can be in your own personal car, a car of a friend, neighbor or family member, or on a bus or a van. You can also get a ride on a city bus or from a group in your town or area. You must use the least costly mode of transportation to get to appointments. In order for Medicaid to pay for a ride, the person who is going to the doctor or clinic must have full Medicaid on the day of medical/clinic appointment and must call in their ride request to the Medicaid Call Center. In order for Medicaid to pay for a ride, you (or someone who is helping you) will need to call Medicaid's **toll-free number at 1-800-362-1504**, press option "4," within 14 days before the date of the appointment or within 24 hours after the appointment, if necessary.
