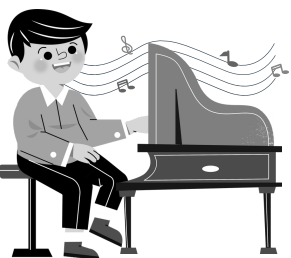
Two opportunities to help with Beans & Rice this week!
